How to Pray by Pete Greig | Our recommended book for Lent this year is 'How to Pray' by Pete Greig. This book will help you build up your prayer life and our Sunday teaching will unpack several of the books key themes during Lent. Lectio divina | Please visit the website to find all our prayer toolbox talks. Last week Helen White shared with us the practice of lectio divina. This is a way of slowly reading scripture and allowing a single word or phrase to speak to you. The method is below.

1. Pick a passage of scripture - psalms are a good place to start e.g. 23 or 139
2. Read s l o w l y !
3. Pause
4. Read again s l o w l y ! And allow a word or phrase to jump out at you
5. Allow God to speak through the words
6. Rest and take in what God is saying
